CLINIC INFORMATION

- Participants will be chosen from entries submitted prior to **March 19, 2017**.
- Successful participants will be contacted by email or telephone by **March 26, 2017** payment is required by **March 31, 2017**.
- **Cost per clinic is \$50 for one day or \$125 for three days**, clinic fees include **one complimentary day pass** to the Expo (for the day of your clinic) or a **weekend wristband** if you are riding all three days of the expo.
- Stalls are available at a cost of \$30.00 for a day stall (8:00 am – 10:00 pm same day), overnight stalls will be invoiced as 2 single day stalls, or \$75.00 for the weekend (Thursday noon – Sunday 7:00 pm). Stalls must be booked & paid for in advance.
- Stall Deposits (separate cheques or credit card) are \$25.00 per stall and must be paid at the time of booking, these will be returned or destroyed after the stall is cleaned and inspected. If you pay by credit card, your number will be kept on file and a \$25.00 charge will be processed if your stall is left dirty.
- Clinic participants will be required to be on-site at least 1 hour prior to the start of their clinic, clean attire, tack and turn-out is required.
- **Any additional people arriving on-site with you will be required to purchase a paid admission.**
- There is no filming or videotaping of any clinics allowed.
- Cancellation of attendance is required at least 48 hours prior to your clinic and a refund will be issued only with a doctor's or veterinarian certificate.

Rules and Conditions:

1. Completion of an Application form does not necessary mean that you will be chosen to participate in the clinic, all applications are reviewed for a good match to the requirements the clinicians has outlined.
2. If you are chosen to participate in a clinic please note that clinic fees include **one** complimentary day pass to the Expo (for the day of your clinic) **or** a **weekend pass** for Friday, Saturday and Sunday **only** if you are riding in clinics all three days of the expo.
3. If you have booked a stall please note that **all** stalls are assigned, there is no changing of stalls allowed. If you wish to be stabled next to or close to another participant please let us know.
4. There are some “community” tack stalls available for use throughout the weekend, these are shared tack stalls so please be considerate. We do not recommend leaving tack in these stalls overnight and Can-Am All Breed Equine Expo **does not** accept any responsibility for lost or stolen items. All items including horses, tack, equipment, vehicles, trailers are left at your own risk.
5. Any horses causing a problem and being a danger to itself or other animals or persons must be removed.
6. We strongly recommend that all clinic participants wear an approved safety helmet. All Juniors **MUST** wear a approved safety helmet.
7. Clinic participants should wear clean and appropriate clothing. Show clothing is not required but we ask that all clothing and equipment be clean and in good condition to show the appropriate respect to the clinician.
8. Riders/handlers are responsible for providing feed, water buckets and wheelbarrows, rakes, shovels. All stalls are to be stripped clean upon departure. Shavings are provided by the Can-Am. Riders/handlers leaving stalls dirty will be subject to a \$25.00 stall cleaning fee.
9. It is important that you check-in so that we do know you are on-site for your clinic.
10. A signed Rider Liability Waiver is required if you are under 19 years of age your parent or guardian will be required to sign this form. If your parent or guardian is not traveling with you please contact our office so a form can be sent out ahead of time.
11. Please be advised that **all persons arriving on-site with you and anyone requiring any access to the grounds will be required to purchase a paid admission**, this includes your coach, spouse and/or children (children under the age of seven are free).
12. Admission is by wristband only so please ensure that you wear your wristband at all times.
13. Please note that there is no filming or videotaping of any clinics or demonstrations allowed.
14. You are responsible for being at the appropriate venue in time for your clinic there will be no delays or refunds for late participants.
15. Cancellation is required at least 48 hours in advance and a refund will only be issued with a doctor's or veterinarian's certificate received prior to the 48 hour cut-off.
16. A DVD or youtube link **is required** if you are applying to participate in the jumping/equitation clinics. For the Dressage clinics please indicate your scores at shows. A DVD or youtube is not required for any other clinics.
